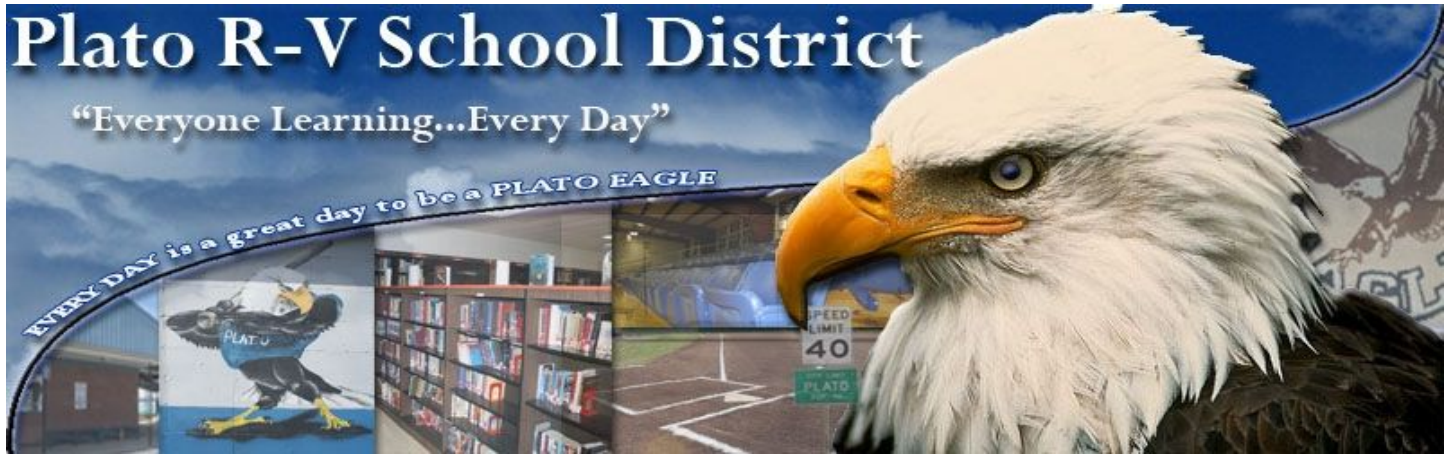

Plato R-V School District - Proposed Tax Levy Impact Project K.I.D.S (Keep Improving District Schools)

The Board of Education voted to present a tax levy increase on the April 4th, 2017 ballot. The 33 cent increase will raise our local levy from \$2.86 per \$100 of assessed valuation to \$3.19 starting in 2017 providing funds to assist the school in making improvements to our buildings and grounds. If passed, the levy will generate an estimated \$108,956 per year.

Funds will be used to make improvements identified in 2013 by a large committee of patrons including: building a vocational center/agricultural facility; improving heat, air, and ventilation; and making technology, safety, and maintenance improvements. We will tackle the projects in small steps based on what we can afford to pay from the funds generated by the levy and by taking out short-term loans and using the levy funds to make payments for some of the larger projects.

Local taxes are a primary funding source for our district. Property taxes are based on a percentage of the value of the property with different types of property taxed at different rates. Tables on the back of this document help explain the impact of the levy.
